There is no question that the General Elections of 2012 are one of the most important in generations. We have before us clear choices. We will decide whether we want America, and California in particular, to continue down the path of left-wing extremism, or if we want our country and our state to make a drastic change to restore liberty and freedom and reject the growing socialism that is being fueled by our present government leaders.

Nationally, if we don't defeat President Barack Hussein Obama, we will get more government, more program disasters like "Operation Fast and Furious"; more scandals where millions of taxpayer dollars are wasted on parties and conventions for government employees like the \$830,000 Las Vegas wing-ding by the Department of General Services, and, the \$5,000,000 spent by the Department of Veterans Affairs to hold a couple of conferences in Orlando or how about the Secret Service scandals with prostitutes in Cartagena Columbia and "animal house" behavior in Martha's Vineyard; more Solyndra's; more Obama-care. In California, if we do not have a significant impact in the legislative elections, Governor Jerry Brown, Senate Pro-Tem Darrell Steinberg and Assembly Speaker John Perez will continue to have a field day destroying our gun rights and our ability to hunt and enjoy the outdoors.

Although Gun Owners of California, in cooperation with others, was successful in stopping SB 249 the bill to ban most semi-auto rifles sold in California today, we were unable to compel Governor Jerry Brown to keep the commitments he made as "candidate" Jerry Brown, to be good on guns and hunting. Instead, at the rate he is going, Governor Jerry Brown is on track to sign more anti-gun legislation into law than any previous Governor. This year he wiped out an entire segment of our hunting community by signing SB 1221 and eliminated what federal courts have said is our only remaining remedy to

exercise our Second Amendment rights and that is open carrying of firearms. Last year he banned open carry of handguns and this year he banned long guns too.

This is our chance to fight back. Do not pay attention to the polls or the mainstream media. We can make a difference. We have an opportunity to tell President Obama and Governor Brown "NO MORE!" Every gun owner, every shooter, every hunter and outdoorsman must do their part. We all must vote pro-gun!
